ORDINANCE NUMBER 2010-04
“An Ordinance to Increase the Fees Charged for Certified Copies”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lambertville, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey that the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Lambertville, 1990, amended to include the following section:

SECTION 1: Section 3-14 Fees Charged by Various Departments, Boards and Commissions of the City of Lambertville is amended as follows:

- a. City Clerk’s Office.
 1. Certified Copies of Birth, Marriage, Civil Union and Domestic Partner Licenses shall be charged a fee of \$15 per certified copy.
 2. Certified Copies of all Death Certificates shall be charged a fee of \$25 for the first certified copy and \$2 for each additional copy for each order placed.
 3. Corrections shall be charged a fee of \$10 per correction filed.

Public Hearing and Final Adoption: February 16, 2010

Date of Adoption: March 10, 2010

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a Regular Meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lambertville held on January 18, 2010 and was read for the first time. Notice of pending Ordinance was advertised on January 21, 2010 in the Times.

This ordinance was considered for second reading and adopted after a public hearing at the regularly scheduled meeting of Mayor and Council of February 16, 2010, held at the Justice Center, 25 So. Union Street, in the City of Lambertville in the County of Hunterdon in the State of New Jersey. Notice of Adoption was advertised on February 18, 2010 in the Times.

After a passage of 20 days, with no record of protest signed by any person against making the improvement or incurring the indebtedness authorized therein, nor any petition requesting that a referendum vote be taken on the action proposed in the ordinance has been presented to the governing body or to me or filed in my office within 20 days after the publication or at any other time after the final passage thereof.
