**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2010-09**

*“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LAMBERTVILLE, 1990, CHAPTER 8: MUNICIPAL PARKING AREAS AND METERED PARKING”*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lambertville, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

**8-20 EXECEPTION FOR CERTAIN HOLIDAYS**

The parking regulations set forth in this article shall not be in effect and will not be enforced on New Year’s Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and from December 17 through December 24. (Ord. #88-25, §5, Amended by Ordinance 2010-09).

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced at a Regular Meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lambertville held on March 15, 2010 and was read for the first time. Notice of pending Ordinance was advertised on March 19, 2010 in the Times.

This ordinance was considered for second reading and finally adopted after a public hearing at the regularly scheduled meeting of Mayor and Council of April 19, 2010, held at the Justice Center, 25 So. Union Street, in the City of Lambertville in the County of Hunterdon in the State of New Jersey. Notice of Adoption was advertised on April 23, 2010 in the Times.

After a passage of 20 days, with no record of protest signed by any person against making the improvement or incurring the indebtedness authorized therein, nor any petition requesting that a referendum vote be taken on the action proposed in the ordinance has been presented to the governing body or to me or filed in my office within 20 days after the publication or at any other time after the final passage thereof.
