SUBURBAN CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC. (SCE) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 26, 2020 relative to the above referenced railroad crossing. SCE has reviewed the letter with the City and offers the following comments.

Bridge Street is a major thoroughfare through the heart of Lambertville as well as a significant Delaware River crossing. Any disruption of traffic along this section of roadway has severe impacts on the travelling public and local economy. Although we understand that infrastructure repair work is necessary, we also endeavor to minimize the disruption such work will cause.

Local disruption can be greatly reduced by coupling permanent railroad repair work with the planned bridge project on Bridge Street. Conducting the work simultaneously will reduce the amount of time the community at large is negatively impacted. Therefore, we request that only temporary pothole patching be conducted at the track location in the interim until the larger bridge project takes place and permanent repairs can be made.
