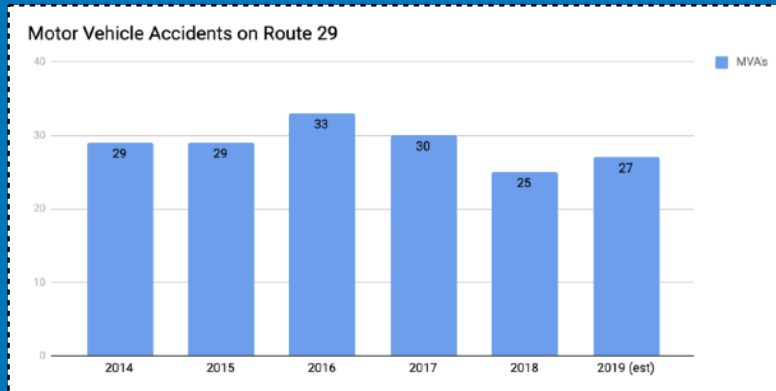

History

2000
Bike/Pedestrian Improvement plan completed, calling for improvements to Rt 29

2001
TAP grant applied for and received - work ongoing until 2005

2003
RWJ Foundation grant secured to help create traffic calming plan, including public meetings

2003
State of NJ creates new Scenic Byway Plan

2016
The City requested from the State a reduction in speed on Route 29 below 40 mph

2017
NJ DOT denies request for lowering speed on Route 29

2018
Community requested reduction in speed again. City was denied request by NJ DOT

2019
City requests lane and/or speed reduction to NJ DOT again. Agreement is reached to explore options

2019
City Engineering and stakeholders finalize plan with NJ DOT based on prior community input for speed, parking, walkability, and prior community feedback
