  - HALT – With Congressman Malinowski, conducted 3 homeowner visits in Delaware Township 3 weeks ago and 4/12 3 more ~ Kingwood area.
    - Malinowski getting reinvigorated regarding PennEast
    - Malinowski contacted White House re: Solicitor General brief. Not an issue on radar and no direction was provided to Solicitor General.
    - Malinowski now preparing communication (potentially via John Kerry) re: challenges with FERC and encouraging admin to take stance. NJCF provided input, HALT requested for input. See talking points attached.
    - HALT requested Malinowski to contact FERC, both Chaterjee & Glick. Reopened docket on how FERC engages communities for comments. HALT is preparing instructions for commenting with talking points, will be sending out to HALT distribution. Talking points highlights: Given reform should happen, and all other outstanding issues, PennEast should be stopped until resolution
    - Considering asking Cittarelli to clarify position on PennEast. No specific action yet.
  - Open application before DRBC, formal comment period not yet begun.
  - Draft ordinance – A Resolution Calling on Governor Phil Murphy, U.S. Senators Bob Menendez and Cory Booker, and Congressman Tom Malinowski to Encourage the Biden Administration to Reverse its Support of the Penn East Pipeline’s Use of Eminent Domain to take New Jersey Property
